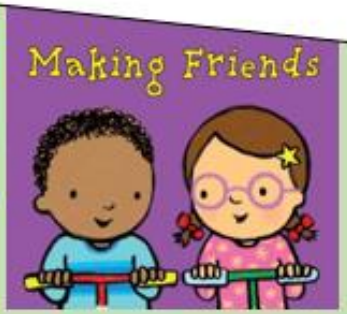
## My Family and Me

I will begin to talk about some of the jobs that I do within my family and how I feel that I belong.



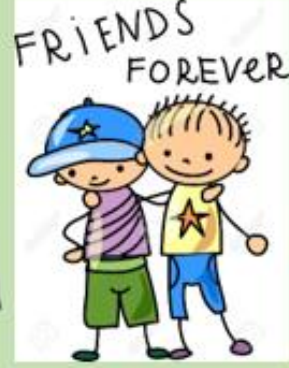
## Making Friends, Make Friends, Never Ever Break Friends.1
