I will be able to make friends to stop myself from feeling lonely.



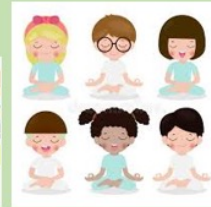
### Make Friends, Make Friends, Never Ever Break Friends 2
