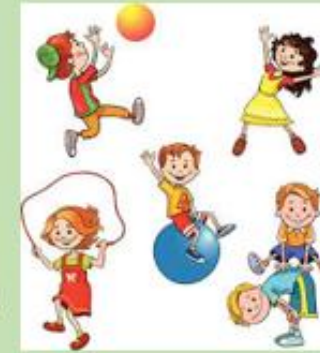
My Body
