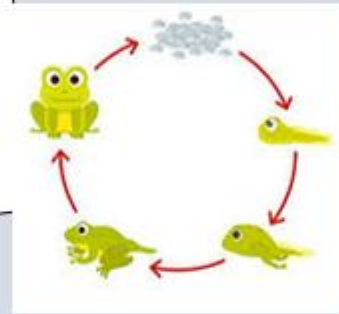


What am I going to be learning during the 'Changing Me' topic for PSHE in Year 2?



Life Cycles in Nature

I will be able to recognise and discuss cycles of life in nature. I will begin to understand how some changes are out of my control and how I feel about these.
